

The Research Centre of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts (ZRC SAZU) is the leading research organization in Slovenia and a prominent actor in Central Europe. ZRC SAZU comprises 18 institutes engaged in fields ranging from the humanities and social sciences to natural sciences. Currently, it employs over 300 researchers, many of whom also participate in the public sphere, providing expert commentary on today's critical societal issues. Thoroughly embedded in the international research landscape, ZRC SAZU has long-standing collaborations with national and international institutions and researchers, who are valuable partners in numerous interdisciplinary projects. Through its in-house publisher Založba ZRC and elsewhere, research results are published in monographs and journals, research maps, films and other publications. ZRC SAZU also presents research results as exhibitions and public events in various contexts aimed at different target groups. ZRC SAZU's holistic approach to research contributes to a better understanding of the complex social, cultural and natural phenomena of the past and present, a crucial element for the sustainable and inclusive development of society.

Who are we – again?

- We participate in up to 300 national and international, basic and applied research projects annually, supported by public and private funders.
- We coordinate the Horizon-ERC project “Unde venis?” Unraveling the enigma of the stećci tombstones.
- For 70 years, we have been measuring and analyzing Triglav Glacier.
- We regularly publish 14 scientific and 3 professional journals.
- We publish *The New Slovenian Biographical Lexicon* and the literary series *Collected Works of Slovenian Poets and Writers*.
- We provide pertinent information and advice on using standard Slovenian language through our dictionaries, collections, and linguistic handbooks and sources, which are accessible on our portals Fran, Franček, Franja, Linguistic Consultancy, and Terminologišče.
- We collect and curate data for the further research of the Slovenian natural and cultural heritage. Our largest collections are FloVegSi (Slovenian Fauna, Flora and Vegetation) and ARKAS (Archaeological Cadastre of Slovenia).
- We organise numerous events, such as Days of Ethnographic Film, the Historical Seminar, the concert cycle Harmonia Concertans, the International Karstological School, and Slovenian Regional Days.
- We maintain the Sound Archive at the Institute of Ethnomusicology.
- We create topographies, among which, the topography of Slovenian migration patterns and the topography of the art and history of Slovenia deserve special mention.
